### **Wayne Pacelle**

As president and chief executive officer of The Humane Society of the United States (HSUS), Wayne Pacelle leads the nation's largest animal protection organization. In 2004, *The Washington Post* called Wayne "the face of the next generation of influential and ambitious animal advocacy", and in 2005 *The NonProfit Times* named him Executive of the Year for his leadership of The HSUS's response to Hurricane Katrina. Since joining The HSUS in 1994, he has led the way in passing more than a dozen federal laws and more than 20 statewide ballot initiatives to protect animals, including measures to outlaw cockfighting, steel-jaw leghold traps, mourning dove shooting, and inhumane factory farming methods. His efforts to unite humane organizations have resulted in unions with The Fund for Animals and the Doris Day Animal League—and the combined organizations are making remarkable gains for animal protection. He is a 1987 graduate of Yale University.
