LAST YEAR 90,000 AMERICAN HORSES WERE KILLED in three foreign-owned U.S. slaughterhouses for export or shipped to Canada and Mexico for slaughter. Americans don't eat horsemeat, but our thoroughbreds, mustangs, carriage horses, and family ponies are shipped to restaurants in France, Belgium, and other European and Asian countries.

Sens. John Ensign (R-NV) and Robert Byrd (D-WV) are leading the charge to end horse slaughter. The House of Representatives recently approved—in a landslide vote—a bipartisan amendment to stop the slaughter of horses. This week the Senate will vote on protecting America's horses from this cruel fate.
