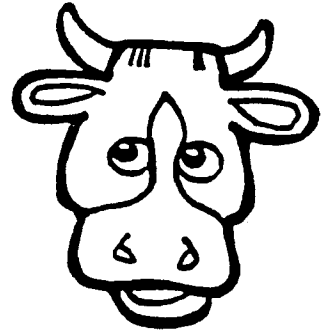

Activity: "Who Am I?" Match The Behavior With The Correct Animal.

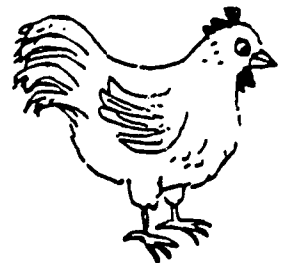

12. I give more milk when I hear my favorite music. _____

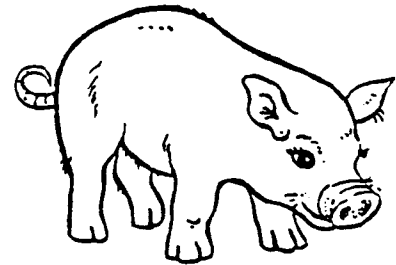
