### 2.31 (c) (3)

#### **INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).**

Section 2.31(c)(3) ? IACUC Functions. The IACUC, as an agent of the research facility, shall prepare reports of its evaluations conducted as required by paragraphs (c)(1) and (2) of this section, and submit the reports to the Institutional Official of the research facility. The reports shall be reviewed and signed by a majority of the IACUC members and must include any minority views. The reports shall be updated at least once every six months upon completion of the required semiannual evaluations and shall be maintained by the research facility and made available to APHIS and to officials of funding Federal agencies for inspection and copying upon request. The reports must contain a description of the nature and extent of the research facility's adherence to this subchapter, must identify specifically any departures from the provisions of title 9, chapter 1, subchapter A--Animal Welfare, and must state the reasons for each departure. The reports must distinguish significant deficiencies from minor deficiencies. A significant deficiency is one which, with reference to Subchapter A, and, in the judgment of the IACUC and the Institutional Official, is or may be a threat to the health or safety of the animals. If program or facility deficiencies are noted, the reports must contain a reasonable and specific plan and schedule with dates for correcting each deficiency. Any failure to adhere to the plan and schedule that results in a significant deficiency remaining uncorrected shall be reported in writing within 15 business days by the IACUC, through the Institutional Official, to APHIS and any Federal agency funding that activity.

.- The semi-annual report of the IACUC's review of the research facility's program for humane care and use of animals and the IACUC's facility inspection covering the period of July 1 to December 31, 2008, was not available at the time of inspection. This report could not be found by the IACUC Chair. The semi-annual reports must be available during the inspection, all reports must distinguish between significant and minor deficiencies, and correction dates must be given and adhered to.
