Without these signed documents we cannot be certain the IACUC members approved of the reports. The reports should be reviewed and signed by a majority of the IACUC members and should be made available to APHIS for inspection.

Similar citations were noted on the June 1, 2004 and September 10, 2004 inspection reports.

(d) Waste disposal. Provision shall be made for the removal and disposal of animal and food wastes, bedding, dead animals, and debris. Disposal facilities shall be so provided and operated as to minimize vermin infestation, odors, and disease hazards.

***The facility is not currently housing any covered species. At time of inspection, 3-5 empty rabbit enclosures were noted to have food receptacles filled with feed. The presence of old or unused food in vacant enclosures does not constitute good husbandry practices and may attract pests, produce odors, or increase disease hazards. Provision

There was a review of the research facility's program for human care and use of animals and animal facilities conducted in June 2006 and another review conducted 9 months later in March of 2007. The review was 3 months past due. The facility must complete a program review and inspect the facility every six months to maintain an adequate evaluation of the program.
