INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

Sec. 2.31 Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC).

(c) IACUC functions. With respect to activities involving animals, the IACUC, as an agent of the research facility, shall: (1) Review, at least once every six months, the research facility's program for humane care and use of animals, using title 9, chapter I, subchapter A--Animal Welfare, as a basis for evaluation; (2) Inspect, at least once every six months, all of the research facility's animal facilities, including animal study areas, using title 9, chapter I, subchapter A-Animal Welfare, as a basis for evaluation; Provided, however, That animal areas containing free-living wild animals in their natural habitat need not be included in such inspection;

IACUC reviews of the research facility and inspection of the animal facility were not done in the time frames indicated in the above regulation. Reviews and inspections were conducted in October 2007 and June 2008. This is an 8 month interval between IACUC program reviews and facility inspections.

The recent move to a new facility has caused more than 6 months to pass for the currently scheduled IACUC review of the facility. The IACUC must meet the requirements in the above regulation and have the reports available for USDA inspection.
