In addition, the plan must be approved by the attending veterinarian. The plan must include written standard procedures to be followed in providing the opportunity for exercise. The plan must be made available to APHIS upon request, and, in the case of research facilities, to officials of any pertinent funding Federal agency.

(b) IACUC Membership. (3) Of the members of the Committee: (ii) At least one shall not be affiliated in any way with the facility other than as a member of the Committee, and shall not be a member of the immediate family of a person who is affiliated with the facility. The Secretary intends that such person will provide representation for general community interests in the proper care and treatment of animals;

The IACUC has not had an active community member since their September 2007 meeting. IACUC minutes indicated the community member resigned in April 2008. There was minimal discussion in the minutes about replacing the community member. The above regulations require a community member on the IACUC.

INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

(d) IACUC review of activities involving animals (ix) Activities that involve surgery include appropriate provision for pre-operative and post-operative care of the animals in accordance with established veterinary medical and nursing practices. All survival surgery will be performed using aseptic procedures, including surgical gloves, masks, sterile instruments, and aseptic techniques. Major operative procedures on non-rodents will be conducted only in facilities intended for that purpose which shall be operated and maintained under aseptic conditions. Non-major operative procedures and all surgery on rodents do not require a dedicated facility, but must be performed using aseptic procedures. Operative procedures conducted at field sites need not be performed in dedicated facilities, but must be performed using aseptic procedures;

The surgical room is used as a storage room. The regulations require that a surgical area be operated and maintained under aseptic conditions. The current condition of the surgical suite does not meet the above regulations. If an emergency were to happen with an animal the surgical room could not be used and surgical procedures would be performed in rooms not authorized for such procedures.
