SANITATION.

(c) Housekeeping. Premises (buildings and grounds) shall be kept clean and in good repair in order to protect the animals from injury and to facilitate the prescribed husbandry practices set forth in this subpart. Premises shall remain free of accumulations of trash.

-Two rabbit restrainers and two utility tables are not adequately cleaned. Lots of hairs and pieces of cotton with dried blood are noted on these equipment including a wood test tube holder that was also covered with dried blood.

-Washing sink is cluttered with plastic containers, cup, two dried dirty towels, dust, hairs and two pieces of wood with dried blood.

These may be a potential cause for contamination if not corrected in a timely manner. Facility shall ensure that these housekeeping items are monitored for compliance. CORRECT BY JULY 6, 2009.

-Unlabeled squeeze bottle with a clear liquid is noted in the work area. This can be mistakenly use for purposes other than what it is intended and may cause undue harm to the rabbit. Facility shall ensure that all squeeze bottles are properly labeled to prevent unnecessary harm to the animal. CORRECT BEFORE END OF DAY, JUNE 30, 2009.

Section 3.56 (c) Housekeeping

Premises (buildings and grounds) shall be kept clean and in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to facilitate the prescribed husbandry practices set forth in this subpart. Premises shall remain free of accumulations of trash.

-Unlabeled squeeze bottles with clear liquid are noted on table together with other bleeding equipment. Each can be used by mistake for purposes other than it is intended and may cause harm to animals.

-Lots of rabbit hairs are noted on two restrainers which had been used in previous days. Test tube holders are noted with large amount of dried blood. Dirty utility table with large amount of hairs and other miscellaneous items are also noted in the barn. Floor in working area are noted with hairs, dirt and other trash scattered.

Management shall ensure that facility is kept clean.

Inspector will be notified after corrections are made for above items.
