The manufacturer does not guarantee the stability of the medical materials beyond its expiration date. Expired medical materials may degrade to toxic by products and may harm the animals if used on them. A system must be in place to ensure that all expired medical materials be identified, labeled and stored in an area separate from the non-expired medical materials or properly disposed of on a regular basis.
