SANITATION.

<<Housekeeping. Premises (buildings and grounds) shall be kept clean and in good repair in order to protect the animals from injury and to facilitate the prescribed husbandry practices set forth in this subpart. Accumulations of trash shall be placed in designated areas and cleared as necessary to protect the health of the animals.>>

The primary enclosure for 2 horses at the north end of the campus has excess metal cattle panels stored adjacent to the shelter structure and has a large dumpster for collection of construction materials from an adjacent facility building. These items are not needed for prescribed husbandry practices and pose a risk for injury to the animals housed in this enclosure.

The premises shall be kept clean and in good repair to protect the animals from injury and accumulations of trash shall be placed in designated areas and cleared as necessary to protect the animals.

The cattle panels shall be moved out of the enclosure by 5/16/10 and the dumpster shall be relocated out of the enclosure by 5/22/10.
