INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

Section 2.31(e) A proposal to conduct an activity involving animals, or to make a significant change in an ongoing activity involving animals, must contain the following: (3) A complete description of the proposed use of the animals.

1. Review of Animal Care Protocol NBR-2009-005 that described a pulmonary ventilation study involving pigs, including the use of a neuromuscular blocking agent: The proposal failed to describe the frequency of administration for multiple doses of the neuromuscular blocking agent given to the animals.

The Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) should ensure that a proposal to conduct an animal activity includes a complete description of the proposed use of the animals.

INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

Section 2.31(c) IACUC Functions. (3) Prepare reports of its evaluations conducted as required by paragraphs (c)(1) and (2) of this section, and submit the reports to the Institutional Official of the research facility. . . .The reports must contain a description of the nature and extent of the research facility's adherence to this subchapter, must identify specifically any departures from the provisions of title 9, chapter I, subchapter A--Animal Welfare, and must state the reasons for each departure. The reports must distinguish significant deficiencies from minor deficiencies. . . .If program or facility deficiencies are noted, the reports must contain a reasonable and specific plan and schedule with dates for correcting each deficiency.

- 1. Review of the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee semiannual report dated March 26, 2009.
 - a. The evaluation of the animal facilities failed to describe the deficiencies noted in this section of the report as a minor or significant deficiency.
 - b. The evaluation of the animal facilities failed to include a schedule with a date for correcting the deficiencies noted in this section of the report.

In accordance with Animal Welfare Regulations, the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) is required to conduct a review of the research facility's program for humane care and use of animals and to inspect the animal facilities at least once every six months; and to submit a report of its evaluations to the Institutional Official at least once every six months to ensure the humane care and use of the animals. The report must identify any deficiency as a minor or significant deficiency. The report must include a description of any deficiencies with details of a plan for correction.

The Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee should submit the corrected report to the Institutional Official.
