SANITATION.

Premises (buildings and grounds) shall be kept clean and in good repair in order to protect the animals from injury and to facilitate the prescribed husbandry practices set forth in this subpart.

The floors in the Core area night houses located in pens #4, #6, & #12 have peeling paint on the floors. The walls in Core area night house # 5 have peeling paint on the walls.

These surfaces now have exposed porous concrete and do not facilitate the proper cleaning & sanitation and are not in good repair.

These surfaces shall be repainted, resurfaced or otherwise be put into good repair.

INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

With respect to activities involving animals, the IACUC, as an agent of the research facility, shall:

- (1) Review, at least once every six months, the research facility's program for humane care and use of animals, using title 9, chapter I, subchapter A--Animal Welfare, as a basis for evaluation;
- (2) Inspect, at least once every six months, all of the research facility's animal facilities, including animal study areas, using title 9, chapter I, subchapter A-Animal Welfare, as a basis for evaluation;

The IACUC has not been meeting every six months and has not performed a site inspection every six months.

The IACUC should have met in June 2007 & June 2008 (which would have been 6 months after its previous meeting). The IACUC did meet and perform a site inspection in December 2006 & December 2007.

The IACUC also performs the site visit after the meeting, so there were no site inspections performed after the missed meeting in June 2007 & June 2008.

The IACUC shall meet & perform a site inspection every six months.
