Each research facility shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include the availability of appropriate facilities, personnel, equipment, and services to comply with the provisions of this subchapter.

Several expired medication were located in the drug cabinets as follows:

- 1-Several vials of Lidocaine exp 11/1/09
- 2-Vial of sterile water exp 1/1/10
- 3-Bottle of Potassium Chloride exp Nov 1 2008
- 4-Several vials of Calcium Chloride exp 10/09

Expired medications are considered adulterated, not an appropriate method to provide adequate veterinary medicine, and therefore cannot be administered to the animals. Establish & implement an effective plan for checking & discarding expired medications.

The IACUC shall determine that the proposed activities or significant changes in ongoing activities meet the following requirements:

The principal investigator has considered alternatives to procedures that may cause more than momentary or slight pain or distress to the animals, and has provided a written narrative description of the methods and sources, e. g., the Animal Welfare Information Center, used to determine that alternatives were not available.

Protocol # 07.10.07 contains surgical procedures that cause more then momentary pain. The principal investigator has not provided any documentation that a search for alternatives was performed.

Protocol 06.09.01 had a continuing review on 8/25/08. The updated protocol only indicated that "there are no new alternatives to my knowledge" The original protocol was approved in Sept 2006. At that time, a literature search only revealed one article on laparoscopic surgery techniques which was published back in 2001.

There have been several advances and articles published using simulator training since 2006. The principal investigator should again perform an updated literature search to see if alternatives are now available. Alternatives not only include using non animal models, but also would include the reduction in animals used in conjunction with simulator or computer training.

Ensure that all principal investigators have searched for alternatives for all protocols that contain potentially painful procedures, and that these searches are updated periodically to ensure that the most current information is provided to the IACUC for its consideration.
