### SANITATION.

(a) Cleaning of enclosures. Excreta shall be removed from primary enclosures as often as necessary to prevent contamination of the animals contained therein and to minimize disease hazards and to reduce odors. When enclosures are cleaned by hosing or flushing, adequate measures shall be taken to protect the animals confined in such enclosures from being directly sprayed with the stream of water or wetted involuntarily.

\*\*\*Swine enclosures were being cleaned by hose with a power-spray nozzle at time of inspection. The design of the enclosures and number of swine in each enclosure does not allow for hosing of enclosures without involuntary wetting of animals. Hosing of enclosures must be conducted in a manner that prevents animals from being involuntarily sprayed by the hose. Correct by: 17 Apr 08.

Additionally, there were substances for experimental use with no preparation date, received date or expiration date found in a refrigerator in this room. There were medications with expired dates as well. In one of the pre-surgical preparation rooms there were commercially prepared medical fluids that were outdated. This may pose a hazard to animals that need veterinary medical care or undergo experimental procedures and are expected to survive these procedures as the use of outdated substances or preparations may lead to negative health issues for the animal. The use of medicines and substances that are within the recommended or commonly used manufacturer's date would be optimal and congruent with good veterinary care and animal husbandry practices.
