ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE.

2.33(a) (1) - Each research facility shall employ an attending veterinarian under formal arrangements. In the case of a part-time attending veterinarian or consultant arrangements, the formal arrangements shall include a written program of veterinary care and regularly scheduled visits to the research facility. The written program of veterinary care does not include bats. These animals must be included to help ensure that they receive adequate care under the guidance of the facilities attending veterinarian.
