Sec. 2.33 Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care.

...(b) Each research facility shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include:

(1) The availability of appropriate facilities, personnel, equipment, and services to comply with the provisions of this subchapter;...

The refrigerator in Unit 2 IH contains expired medications. A bottle of Heparin Lot No: 115091 is noted to have expired 05/2007. A bottle of Draxxin Lot No: K6A02111 is noted to have expired 10/2009.

Medications may not act as intended or expected when utilized beyond their expiration dates. This can affect the animal's health and well being. Facility needs to insure that expired medications are not used in regulated animals. Correct by: 18 June 2010.

#### SANITATION.

Sec. 3.131 Sanitation.

(d) Pest control. A safe and effective program for the control of insects, ectoparasites, and avian and mammalian pests shall be established and maintained.

Feed storage sheds and animal housing buildings have debris accumulations and overgrown vegetation near the exterior walls of these structures. Rodent feces is observed within the feed storage building.

Debris and overgrown vegetation near these feed storage sheds promotes vermin infestation and increases disease hazards. This can affect the animal's health and well being. Facility needs to remove debris and control weed growth near buildings. Correct by: 19 July 2010.
