A sampling of the dogs in kennel #2 KA, Greyhound named "Tina" tattoo 241 E exhibited heavy dental calculi, gingivitis and gingival recession as did "Hope" tattoo 1120D, a black grey hound, dog with tattoo CNSICR mixed mongrel coonhound, dog with 140C tattoo, dog tattoo CPVIIV a black coonhound, "Houdini" ear tattoo 11504, whose left lower molars were heavily encrusted with dental calculi and gingivitis. Another sampling of dogs in kennel B exhibited dog tattoo 22 a coonhound and tattoo 34 a greyhound with heavy dental calculi on the molars and associated gingivitis. 100% of the sampled dogs selected for oral exams had significant oral lesions and clearly present pathology.

It is important to the health and well-being of the dogs to have regular oral examinations, dental prophylaxis as needed and close follow-up care to re-evaluate their condition.

The above listed dogs should have dental prophylaxes as needed to establish good oral health.

A sampling of the dogs in kennel #2 KA, greyhound names "Tina" tattoo 241 E exhibited heavy dental calculi, gingivitis and gingival recession, as did "Hope" tattoo 1120D, a black greyhound, dog with with Tattoo CNSICR, a mixed mongrel coonhound, dog with tattoo 140C, dog with tattoo CPVIAY a black coonhound, "Houdini" ear tattoo 11504, whose left lower molars were heavily encrusted with dental calculi and associated gingivitis. Another sampling of dogs in kennel B notably a coonhound tattoo 22 and a greyhound tattoo 34 had heavy dental calculi on their molars and associated gingivitis. 100% of the sampled dogs selected for oral exams had significant oral lesions and clearly present pathology.

It is important to the health and well-being of the dogs to have regularly scheduled oral exams, dental prophylaxis as needed and close follow care to re-evaluate their overall health.

The above listed dogs should have dental prophylaxes as needed to establish good oral health.
