INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

2.31(c) IACUC Functions. With respect to activities involving animals, the IACUC, as an agent of the research facility, shall:

(1) Review, at least once every six months, the research facility's program for humane care and use of animals, using title 9, chapter I, subchapter A--Animal Welfare, as a basis for evaluation;

(2) Inspect, at least once every six months, all of the research facility's animal facilities, including animal study areas, using title 9, chapter I, subchapter A-Animal Welfare, as a basis for evaluation; Provided, however, That animal areas containing free-living wild animals in their natural habitat need not be included in such inspection;

(3) Prepare reports of its evaluations conducted as required by paragraphs (c)(1) and (2) of this section, and submit the reports to the Institutional Official of the research facility. The reports shall be updated at least once every six months upon completion of the required semiannual evaluations and shall be maintained by the research facility and made available to APHIS and to officials of funding Federal agencies for inspection and copying upon request.

****The semi-annual program review, facility inspection and report to the Institutional Official are not being conducted at least every six months. A semi-annual program and facility review along with the report to the Institutional Official were executed on 2/16/06 and the next review and report were completed on 10/27/06. The facility must conduct the semi-annual reviews and update the report to the Institutional Official at least every 6 months as required by the Animal Welfare Regulations.
