#### INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

A proposal to conduct an activity involving animals, or to make a significant change in an ongoing activity involving animals, must contain a rationale for involving animals, and for the appropriateness of the species and numbers of animals to be used.

\*\*\*The surgery demonstration protocols did not indicate an appropriate or complete justification for the use of the dog as species or the number to be used. Protocols should include a rationale for using the species chosen and for the number to be used addressing reduction in numbers. The protocol must contain an appropriate rationale for the species chosen and the number of animals to be used to assist the IACUC in determining that proposed activities are not unnecessarily duplicative and that alternatives have been considered.
