REQUIREMENTS AND APPLICATION.

All survival surgery will be performed using aseptic procedures, including surgical gloves, masks, sterile instruments, and aseptic techniques. Major operative procedures on non-rodents will be conducted only in facilities intended for that purpose which shall be operated and maintained under aseptic conditions. Non-major operative procedures and all surgery on rodents do not require a dedicated facility, but must be performed using aseptic procedures.

***Under ASP 65, embryo transfer procedures on recipient rodents are performed using microsurgical instruments "sterilized" in 70% ethanol for 24 to 72 hours. By definition, the instruments are not considered sterile, as ethanol does not kill spores. The current sterilization method has been shown to be clinically effective, as evident by no post-operative infections. However, a qualitative method to determine the efficacy of the sterility method should be established to ensure aseptic technique is used when performing the embryo transfers. Or, another method of sterilization must be used to ensure the embryo transfers are performed aseptically. Correct by November 30, 2007.
