ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE.

Item Veterinary Care 2.33 b 5

Each research facility shall establish and maintain a program of adequate veterinary care to include adequate pre-procedural and post procedural care in accordance with current established veterinary medical and nursing procedures.

Gerbil protocol 05-001 involves surgery, protocol indicates Carprofen, Rimadyl 5mg/kg SC daily for 2 days. The protocol also indicates Baytril 5 mg/kg SID on the day of surgery and for 2 days after surgery, and Xylocaine 0.1 cc SQ as local anesthesia at the incision site. In reviewing post-op records there is no documentation as to how much Rimadyl or Baytril was given to the animal or route of administration nor is there any indication that xylocaine was given along the incision site.

The protocol also indicates that the animals will be monitored during anesthesia by rate of respiration, movement and pinching reflex.

There is no documentation that any of the above monitoring was performed.

Facility needs to insure that documentation for monitoring of animals before during and after surgical procedures is performed accurately.
