#### INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

2.31 (e) (2) - "A proposal to conduct an activity involving animals, or to make a significant change in an ongoing activity involving animals, must contain the following: (2) A rationale for involving animals, and for the appropriateness of the species and numbers of animals to be used."

##### 1. Review of Protocol # 08-04:

a. The proposal for animal use that was approved on 2/12/08 states that there are 2 Groups, each group containing 10 Goats, that will be used for a total of 20 Goats. However, the narrative of the animal use proposal does not contain any rationale for the appropriateness of the number of animals included in the proposal.

A proposal for animal use must contain a rationale for the appropriateness of the numbers of animals to be used. The IACUC needs to address this issue identified for this proposal. Correct by 11/10/08.

### 2.33 (b) (1)

#### ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE.

2.33 (b) (1) - "Each research facility shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include: (1) The availability of appropriate facilities, personnel, equipment, and services to comply with the provisions of this subchapter."

1. The following outdated medications were identified in the Surgical Area during the inspection. The use of outdated medications may not be safe or efficacious and is not considered an acceptable standard of veterinary practice. The Registrant corrected this item at the time of the inspection by removing the outdated medications from the area and discarding them.

a. Sterile water for injection, 20 ml bottles, #3, exp 4/1/07

b. Heparin solution, 10 ml bottles, #25, exp 8/08; 10 ml bottles, #50, exp 9/08

**ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE.**

2.33 (b) (2) - "Each research facility shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include:  
(2) The use of appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries."

1. Sheep #239 was noted by the APHIS inspector to have long hooves on both front feet.

Regular trimming of the hooves is important to prevent overgrowth and ensure animal comfort. The condition of the hooves of the Sheep needs to be addressed by the facility. Correct by 10/15/08.

2. One Rabbit in Rm D was noted by the APHIS inspector to have a runny eye and the fur in the medial canthus area of the face was wet and separated. The eye condition in the Rabbit had not been identified by personnel.

A research facility should maintain a program of veterinary care that includes the use of appropriate methods to diagnose and treat animal health issues so that any animal health problem can be appropriately addressed. The eye condition in the Rabbit needs to be addressed by the facility. Correct by 10/9/08.
