The IACUC shall conduct continuing reviews of activities covered by this subchapter at appropriate intervals as determined by the IACUC, but not less than annually.

There were 2 protocols (AOK005 and APS006) randomly selected for review during the inspection where the IACUC did not perform an annual review within an annual time period.

The IACUC needs to ensure that all approved protocols are reviewed by the IACUC at least annually to ensure that the IACUC has continued oversight and that the protocols are being followed as written. This ensures the health and wellbeing of the animals.

INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

A proposal to conduct an activity involving animals, or to make a significant change in an ongoing activity involving animals, must contain the following:

- (1) Identification of the species and the approximate number of animals to be used;
- (2) A rationale for involving animals, and for the appropriateness of the species and numbers of animals to be used;
- (3) A complete description of the proposed use of the animals;
- (4) A description of procedures designed to assure that discomfort and pain to animals will be limited to that which is unavoidable for the conduct of scientifically valuable research, including provision for the use of analgesic, anesthetic, and tranquilizing drugs where indicated and appropriate to minimize discomfort and pain to animals; and
- (5) A description of any euthanasia method to be used.

Study Number KGT006 was reviewed during this inspection. The protocol did not accurately describe the complete use of the animals as the procedures involving evaluation after treatment were not adequately described and the description of euthanasia to be performed was not included.

Protocols need to adequately describe all aspects of proposed use of animals, including a description of the method of euthanasia, to ensure that the IACUC has all the information required to make an accurate evaluation of the proposal. This ensures that animals are used appropriately in research and to ensure their health and wellbeing.

Ensure all protocols submitted to the IACUC have the required elements.

Correct from this time forward. This potentially affected 4 animals indirectly.
