FACILITIES, GENERAL.

(a) Structural strength. The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect animals from injury and to properly contain the animals..

Portions of a secondary containment fence for the main deer pens have broken strands of barbed wire at the top and there are also some buckled panels at the top of the fence. The facility manager stated that the damage was caused by downed tree limbs. The facility should be maintained and kept in good repair. Affected animal count: 57.

Correct by May 24, 2010.

The third bobcat enclosure pen has an extremely rusted support post that is need of replacement. Facilities housing the regulated species should be structurally sound and maintained in good repair. Affected animal count: 1.
