INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

(d) IACUC review of activities involving animals.

(1) In order to approve proposed activities or proposed significant changes in ongoing activities, the IACUC shall conduct a review of those components of the activities related to the care and use of animals and determine that the proposed activities are in accordance with this subchapter unless acceptable justification for a departure is presented in writing;Further, the IACUC shall determine that the proposed activities or significant changes in ongoing activities meet the following requirements:

(ii) The principal investigator has considered alternatives to procedures that may cause more than momentary or slight pain or distress to the animals, and has provided a written narrative description of the methods and sources, e. g., the Animal Welfare Information Center, used to determine that alternatives were not available;

A protocol for a veterinary conference ultrasound lab was examined. The laboratory requires sedation in order to treat dogs and cats for distress, but was classified as a Category C rather than Category D. No documentation of consideration of alternatives to this procedure was included in this protocol. IACUC review of all protocols involving more than momentary pain or distress must ensure that these protocols include a written narrative description of the methods and sources used in order to search for alternatives.

The protocol did not contain information about which personnel will be participating in the procedure or information about the qualifications and trainings of these personnel. IACUC review of protocols must ensure that all personnel conducting procedures are appropriately
