Sec. 3.6 Primary enclosures.

Primary enclosures for dogs...must meet the following minimum requirements:

(a) General requirements. (1) Primary enclosures must be designed and constructed of suitable materials so that they are structurally sound. The primary enclosures must be kept in good repair...and

(ix) Enable all surfaces in contact with the dogs...to be readily cleaned and sanitized in accordance with Sec. 3.11(b) of this subpart, or be replaceable when worn or soiled;

2 pens on the south outside of the "west wing"

Boji's pen:

Three 50 cent sized chips in the cement, approximately 3/8" deep.

Bailey's pen:

One 50 cent sized chip in the cement, approximately 3/8" deep.

These cement defects could be areas that would harbor bacteria/viruses and could become difficult to clean. Further, as temperatures fluctuate in this Nebraska climate zone, water could freeze/melt and continue to crack and degrade the cement. These defects should be repaired in order to properly maintain the surfaces. Any other pens showing similar problems should also be maintained/repared.
