Committee members should be appointed by the Chief Executive Officer of the research/teaching facility.

INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

1. Review of the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee draft semiannual report dated October 6, 2009.
 - a. The draft report indicated the review of the research/teaching facility's program for the care and use of animals was conducted on October 6, 2009, approximately seventeen months after completion of the previous review on May 13, 2008. In the absence of further information or records, it could not be determined whether other reviews were conducted in the period between May 13, 2008 and October 6, 2009. [Section 2.31(c)(1)]
 - b. The draft report indicated the inspection of the research/teaching facility's animal facility was conducted on October 6, 2009, approximately seventeen months after completion of the previous inspection on May 13, 2008. In the absence of further information or records, it could not be determined whether other inspections were conducted in the period between May 13, 2008 and October 6, 2009. [Section 2.31(c)(2)]

2. Review of the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee records of IACUC meetings: Available records failed to document or provide evidence that a semiannual report was submitted to the Institutional Official since May 13, 2008. [Section 2.31(c)(3)]

In accordance with Animal Welfare Regulations, the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) is required to conduct a review of the research/teaching facility's program for humane care and use of animals and to inspect the animal facilities at least once every six months; and to submit a report of its evaluations to the Institutional Official at least once every six months to ensure the humane care and use of the animals. The evaluations should be conducted and the report should be submitted within the required interval of time and with the required details.

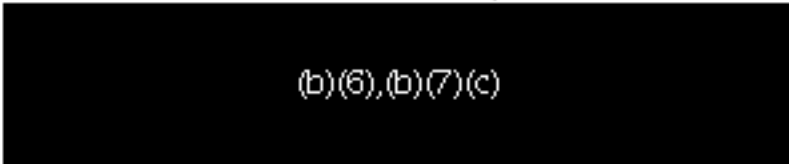
