- 1) Protocol # PIC-52 is a robotics training protocol that calls for the use paralytic agents for certain procedures. However, these drugs are no longer being used and have not been used since 7/08. The protocol was renewed in 6/09. The IACUC needs to ensure that the protocol is amended to reflect the actual procedures that are being performed on the animals.
- 2) The following protocols list personnel that are no longer employed with the facility: TECH-1, PIC-52, PIC-53. The IACUC needs to ensure that the protocol is amended to reflect the current personnel that are working on the protocol.

- (1) Review, at least once every six months, the research facility's program for humane care and use of animals, using title 9, chapter I, subchapter A--Animal Welfare, as a basis for evaluation.
- (2) Inspect, at least once every six months, all of the research facility's animal facilities, including animal study areas, using title 9, chapter I, subchapter A-Animal Welfare, as a basis for evaluation.

During the last three semi-annual inspections/ program reviews (12/6/07, 6/10/08, 11/21/08) the non-affiliated member was not present. The following three members must be present to constitute a fully functioning IACUC: chairman, attending veterinarian, and a non-affiliated member. A fully functioning IACUC must be present to conduct any official business (i.e. semi-annual inspections).
