#### HANDLING OF ANIMALS.

During public exhibition, any animal must be handled so there is minimal risk of harm to the animal and to the public, with sufficient distance and/or barriers between the animal and the general viewing public so as to assure the safety of animals and the public.

At the time of this inspection it was noted that the split rail fence in front of the lemur enclosures was too close to the primary enclosure fencing. This fence is approximately 3' away. However, I was able to reach over the barrier fence and touch the primary fencing. To ensure the safety of the animals and the public this barrier will need to be addressed.

#### FACILITIES, GENERAL.

The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.

1. The newly constructed fox enclosure had a wire mesh installed along the sides and across the entire length of the floor. However, in some areas the substrate along the bottom edge has begun to erode. This is now exposing the wire mesh flooring. To ensure that the foxes do not get injured on this flooring it will need to be addressed.

2. One of the otters is presently being housed in the Small Animal Holding area. However, the pool that this animal has access too has an area of peeling paint. To ensure that this area of the enclosure can be properly cleaned and sanitized it will need to be addressed.
