3.1 (c) (2)

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Section 3.1(c)(2) - Maintenance and Replacement. All surfaces must be maintained on a regular basis. Surfaces that cannot be readily cleaned and sanitized must be replaced when worn or soiled.

- The small animal survival surgery suite "A" has rust appearing on the wall just above the base board. The room cannot be adequately cleaned and disinfected with the rusted wall panels, the panels should be repaired or replaced. Correct by: 11/28/07
- The large animal survival surgery suite "165" has an 8"X12" metal panel on the floor that the door stops fit into. The door stops and the metal panel have rusted, the room cannot be properly cleaned and sanitized. Correct by: 11/28/07
- The floor in the junior surgery room is marked with black marks that need to be removed or the floor repaired so that proper cleaning and disinfecting can be done. Correct by: 12/28/07

3.1 (e)

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Section 3.1 (e) - Storage. Supplies of food and bedding for dogs and cats must be stored in a manner that protects the supplies from spoilage, contamination, and vermin infestation. All open supplies of food and bedding must be kept in leak proof containers with tight fitting lids. Substances that are toxic to the dogs or cats must not be stored in food storage areas but in cabinets in the animal areas.

- One bag of dog food was open in room 023 of bldg #107. The bag should be placed in a container with a tightly fitting lid, to protect the food supply from contamination by pests and/or vermin. Correct by: 9/4/07

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
