INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

IACUC Functions. With respect to activities involving animals, the IACUC, as an agent of the research facility, shall: (1) Review, at least once every six months, the research facility's program for humane care and use of animals, using title 9, chapter I, subchapter A--Animal Welfare, as a basis for evaluation; (2) Inspect, at least once every six months, all of the research facility's animal facilities, including animal study areas, using title 9, chapter I, subchapter A-Animal Welfare, as a basis for evaluation; Provided, however, That animal areas containing free-living wild animals in their natural habitat need not be included in such inspection; (3) Prepare reports of its evaluations conducted as required by paragraphs (c)(1) and (2) of this section, and submit the reports to the Institutional Official (IO) of the research facility.

The last IACUC meeting Minutes on file were from 26 April 2007. The last Semi-annual inspection on file was 1 May 2007. While these reports were submitted to the IO as required, two more reports need to have been completed as indicated above to assure identification of potential problems that may adversely affect the animals. ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE.

Each research facility shall employ an attending veterinarian under formal arrangements. In the case of a part-time attending veterinarian or consultant arrangements, the formal arrangements shall include a written program of veterinary care (PVC) and regularly scheduled visits to the research facility

The PVC on file is more than two years old. While the Attending veterinarian is a voting member of the IACUC, the PVC still needs to be updated yearly by signature of the veterinarian to assure that current information and practices are in effect for the health of the animals. No record of annual Physical examination was present to indicate more recent assesment than the PVC. Correct by: 10 October 2008
