INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

Section 2.31(c)(3) IACUC: The IACUC shall prepare reports of its evaluations conducted as required by paragraphs (c)(1) and (2) of this section, and submit the reports to the Institutional Official of the research facility. The reports shall be reviewed and signed by a majority of the IACUC members. The reports must contain a description of the nature and extent of the research facility's adherence to this subchapter, must identify specifically any departures from the provisions of title 9, chapter I, subchapter A-Animal Welfare. The reports must distinguish significant deficiencies from minor deficiencies. If program or facility deficiencies are noted, the report must contain a reasonable and specific plan and schedule with dates for correcting each deficiency.

The September 18, 2008 IACUC report to the Institutional Official was reviewed and signed by the IACUC members after the report was submitted and only four of the eight members signed the report. A majority of the IACUC members must review and sign the IACUC report before it is submitted to the Institutional Official.

The September 18, 2008 IACUC report did not include a complete description of the IACUC inspection of the off-site animal holding facility. The report did not distinguish significant deficiencies from minor deficiencies and did not include a plan with dates for correcting the deficiencies. The IACUC report to the Institutional Official must contain the required information to keep the Institutional Official informed and to comply with the Animal Welfare regulations.

INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

Section 2.31(e)(2) IACUC: A proposal to conduct an activity involving animals, or to make a significant change in an ongoing activity involving animals, must contain a rationale for involving animals, and for the appropriateness of the species and numbers of animals to be used.

Animal activity proposal #175 does not provide a rationale for the appropriateness of the number of animals requested. Animal proposals must contain a rationale for the number of animals requested to ensure the appropriate number of animals is used and to comply with the animal welfare regulations.
