PERSONNEL QUALIFICATIONS.

Section 2.32(c)(1)(ii) states "Personnel qualifications. Training and instruction of personnel must include guidance in at least the following areas: Humane methods of animal maintenance and experimentation, including: Proper handling and care for the various species of animals used by the facility."

During this inspection, an instrumented rhesus macaque was found restrained in a chair in a sound proof booth performing the trained research tasks. No attendant was present in the room to monitor the condition of the animal via the video monitor or by physical checks.

The attendant returned and when asked, stated he had been away for one hour. He indicated this amount of time was acceptable because the animal could not hurt itself because its neck and head were restrained. This research attendant needs more training in humane methods of animal experimentation. Unattended non-human primates restrained like this can potentially injure themselves; therefore they should never be left unattended.

Part of this citation was corrected immediately by the attendant staying with the animal while it was restrained. A more permanent solution planned for the monitoring is to install remote monitoring devices for when the attendant cannot be in the same room but will be nearby. Any restrained animal is to be monitored by devices or by an attendant present.

Additional training needs to be provided to this research attendant and other members of this research team. To be corrected by 3-14-08.
