### 2.31 (e) (3)

#### INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

Section 2.31(e)(3) states "A proposal to conduct an activity involving animals, or to make a significant change in an ongoing activity involving animals, must contain a complete description of the proposed use of the animals."

Protocol 1477 does not give a complete description of the procedures used to obtain the wild trapped specimens to be obtained. The protocol needs to provide more details as to how many traps will be set at a time, how they will be set up and marked for finding them, what bait will be used, what steps will be taken to prevent non-target mortalities, and what safety precautions will be in place for the personnel involved. Since this protocol has already been initiated, any minor changes made to improve the protocol also need to be described. These details can be described in an amendment to the protocol.

### 2.31 (d) (1) (i)

#### INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

Section 2.31(d)(1)(i) states "IACUC review of activities involving animals. In order to approve proposed activities or proposed significant changes in ongoing activities, the IACUC shall conduct a review of those components of the activities related to the care and use of animals and determine that the proposed activities are in accordance with this subchapter unless acceptable justification for a departure is presented in writing.

Further, the IACUC shall determine that the proposed activities or significant changes in ongoing activities meet the following requirements: Procedures involving animals will avoid or minimize discomfort, distress, and pain to the animals."

Peromyscus protocol 1509 involving embryo transfer to the uterus exteriorized through a paracostal incision states nalbuphine will be given as analgesia prior to recovery and as needed. Medical records for the 7 females having this surgery so far show only the first one was given any analgesic.

Significant changes in protocol, such as not giving an approved analgesic, need to be submitted to and approved by the IACUC. This procedure needs to be evaluated by the new attending veterinarian and recommendations made as to what will be done to avoid or minimize discomfort and pain for the animals.
