Animal areas inside of housing facilities must be kept neat and free of clutter, including equipment, furniture, or stored material, but may contain materials actually used and necessary for cleaning the area, and fixtures and equipment necessary for proper husbandry practices and research needs.

AT THE TIME OF THIS INSPECTION, THE FRONT AND BACK AREAS IN THE DOG ROOM HAD AN ACCUMULATION OF CAGES AND OTHER EQUIPMENT NOT CURRENTLY IN USE. SEVERAL OTHER AREAS SEEMED TO HAVE AN ACCUMULATION OF UNUSED EQUIPMENT. ANIMAL AREAS MUST BE KEPT NEAT AND FREE OF CLUTTER. ADDITIONAL STORAGE SPACE APPEARS TO BE NEEDED AT THIS FACILITY.
