ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE.

<<Each research facility shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include: Daily observation of all animals to assess their health and well-being; Provided, however, That daily observation of animals may be accomplished by someone other than the attending veterinarian; and Provided, further, That a mechanism of direct and frequent communication is required so that timely and accurate information on problems of animal health, behavior, and well-being is conveyed to the attending veterinarian;>>

During the inspection, one hamster being used on a study (#A100801) and which was housed with two other hamsters was noted to have an open wound on its left hip that was actively bleeding. The animal's condition had not been noted by the care staff and no communication had yet been made with the attending veterinarian. This animal needs to be evaluated by a veterinarian as soon as possible to determine how best to address this animal's injury and to relieve any pain and distress.

Daily observation of animals shall be part of the program of adequate veterinary care and should include a mechanism of frequent and direct communication with the attending veterinarian regarding problems of animal health, behavior, and well-being.
