

The Humane Society Walk for the Animals Facebook Causes Contest

Contest Rules

1. Disclosure; Contest Period

No donation, purchase, or obligation of any kind is necessary to win. A donation or purchase will not increase your chances of winning. You have not yet won. The Humane Society Walk for the Animals Facebook Causes Contest begins at 10:00 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time (EDT) on Friday, September 19, 2008 and ends at 10:00 a.m. EDT on Friday, October 17, 2008 (Contest Period).

2. Eligibility

Void where prohibited by law. The Humane Society Walk for the Animals Facebook Causes Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Employees and independent contractors of The Humane Society of the United States (The HSUS) or its affiliates, and any other individual or entity involved in the development, promotion, or execution of the CONTEST, and the immediate family members and/or household members of each are not eligible.

3. To Enter

Enter by creating a new Cause on the Walk's Causes on Facebook page:
<http://www.causes.com/dogwalk>. Existing Causes are not eligible.

You may only create one Cause per person to be eligible.

4. Winning Contestants; Prizes

Winners will be identified on the Walk's Causes on Facebook page. The Causes which raise the most money will be outlined on a "leaderboard" on the page. When the contest expires, a donation will be made in the names of the top five fundraisers to the Humane Society Walk for the Animals via their Cause:

First Place: \$1,500

Second Place: \$1,250

Third Place: \$1,000

Fourth Place: \$750

Fifth Place: \$500

Amounts sent to the winning Causes determined by the leaderboard are final.

5. Winner Notification/Prize Claims

Winners will be announced on October 17, 2008 and will be notified by email and Facebook. Winners may be required to complete and sign an Affidavit of Eligibility and Liability Release, and, where legal, a Publicity Release, all of which must be returned within 30 days of attempted prize notification or the prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner. If the Prize is won by an eligible person who is not of legal age in the state of residence, the prize shall be awarded in the name of the Winner's parent or legal guardian, who must sign and return all required documentation prior to receiving the Prize. In the event of noncompliance with these Rules, or if a Prize or prize notification is unclaimed or returned as undeliverable, the prize will be forfeited and may be awarded to an alternate winner.
