WAYNE PACELLE

As president and chief executive officer of The Humane Society of the United States (HSUS), Wayne Pacelle leads the nation's largest animal protection organization. *The NonProfit Times* named him "Executive of the Year" in 2005, and in 2004, *The Washington Post* labeled Wayne "undeniably ... the face of the next generation of influential and ambitious animal advocacy leadership." In his prior role as senior vice president of The HSUS, he led the way in passing more than a dozen federal laws and 15 statewide ballot initiatives to protect animals. As a result of these efforts to outlaw cockfighting, the use of steel-jaw traps, and inhumane factory farming practices, *Campaigns & Elections* named Wayne "a rising star in politics." He previously served as executive director of The Fund for Animals, and he is a 1987 graduate of Yale University.



THOMAS J. CHARRON

Tom Charron has served as executive director of the National District Attorneys Association (NDAA) and president of the American Prosecutors Research Institute since June 2004. Previously, Tom worked for six years as the NDAA's director of education at the National Advocacy Center. He also served for 21 years as district attorney in Marietta, Georgia, where he managed the third largest prosecutor's office in the state while actively prosecuting many of the more notorious cases in the circuit. Tom received his law degree from Atlanta Law School and a bachelor's in education from Georgia State University. He is admitted to the State Bar of Georgia, the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia, and the U.S. Supreme Court. He has testified extensively before the U.S. Congress and several state legislatures and has lectured on criminal justice and trial advocacy issues throughout the United States, Canada, and the United Kingdom.
