

Voting Instructions: Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Who can vote?

A: Anyone with a valid email address can vote. Votes can only be cast online at http://www.humanesociety.org/forms/congressional_pet_photo_contest_peoples_choice.html.

Q: How many times can I vote?

A: Only one vote per valid email address will be counted.

Q: When can I vote?

A: You may vote online at http://www.humanesociety.org/forms/congressional_pet_photo_contest_peoples_choice.html between 12:00 pm EST on May 23, 2011 and 11:59 pm EST on June 6, 2011.

Q: How do I vote?

A: Go to http://www.humanesociety.org/forms/congressional_pet_photo_contest_peoples_choice.html. Choose your favorite photo and note the name of the pet, then scroll to the bottom of the page. Click the box next to the name of your favorite pet (you may only choose one). Fill out the registration information, including first and last name, email address and zip or postal code. Finally, click "Vote Now."

Q: When will the results be announced?

A: We will reveal the results at http://www.humanesociety.org/forms/congressional_pet_photo_contest_peoples_choice.html shortly after the online vote ends on June 6 at 11:59 pm.
