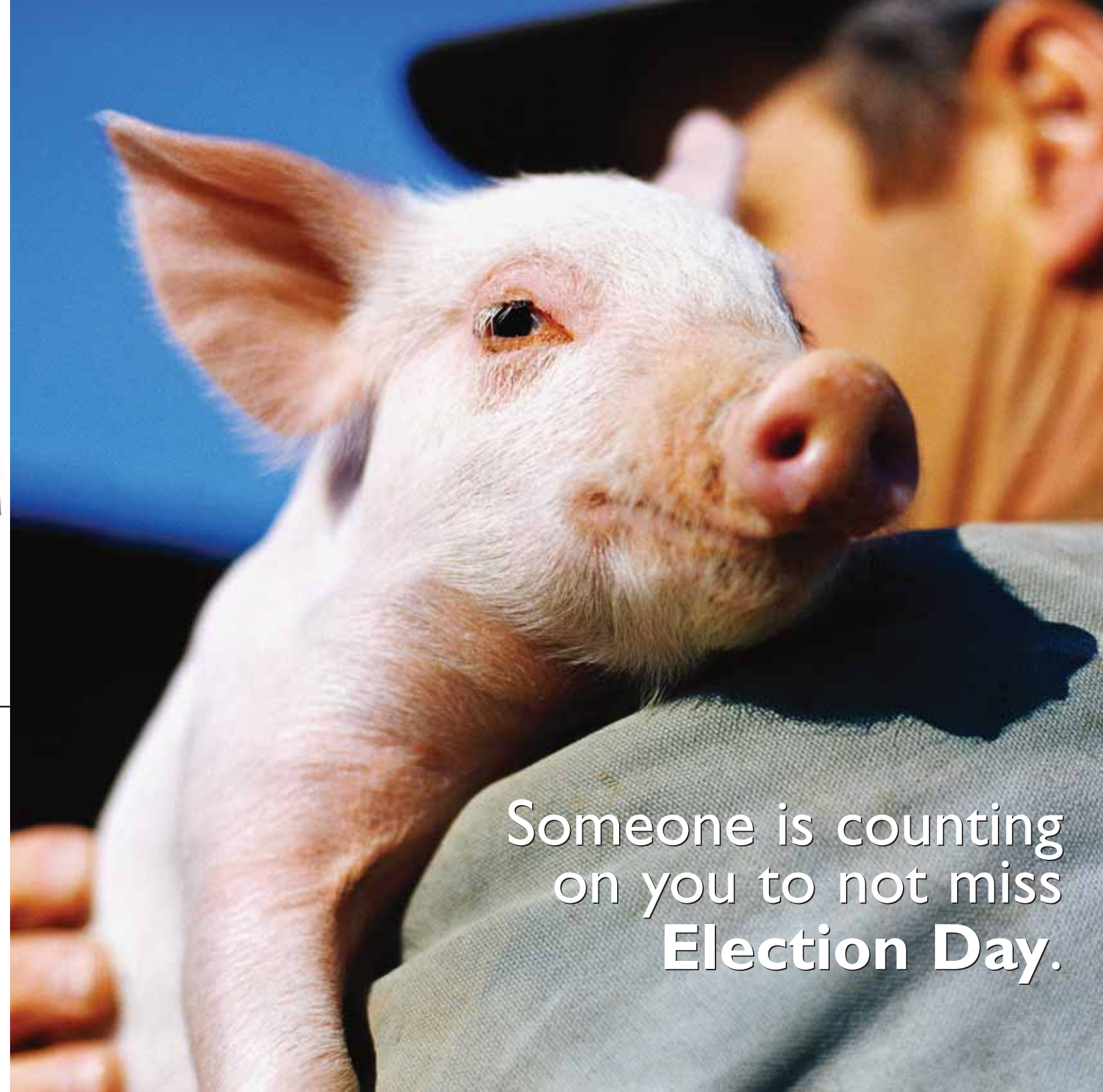

How does it work?

To request an absentee ballot, fill out the attached form, stamp it and send it in immediately. The County Elections Office will receive your application and send you a ballot.

How do I vote?

Fill in your ballot, put a stamp on it and drop it in the mail by November 1st so it reaches your county election office by Election Day, November 7.

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1

Complete the information on the attached form.

STEP 2

Important: Sign the application.

STEP 3

Tear off this card and drop it in the mail today.

NOTE

Forms should be mailed **at least two weeks prior to an election** to receive your absentee ballot by mail.

Remember to notify your County Election office whenever you change your address.
