

JUDGMENT

The Court takes up the above styled cause for ruling, having conducted a trial on the merits on August 9, 2010. Being duly advised in the premises, the Court rules as follows:

1. As a matter of law, the Secretary's summary statement is neither insufficient nor unfair.
2. The Auditor's fiscal note and fiscal note summary are neither insufficient nor unfair.
3. The Auditor's fiscal note process is not an unpromulgated rule.
4. The challenges as to the form of the initiative petition are not yet ripe.
5. Given that the Plaintiff had actual knowledge and more or less immediate notice of the filing with the Secretary of State, she cannot complain that the petition was immediately transferred to the Auditor, thus starting the statutory ten (10) day clock for submission of comments.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

The Official Ballot Title, including the Summary Statement and Fiscal Note Summary, is certified as prepared by the Secretary of State and State Auditor, and Counts I and III of the Petition are denied;

The Fiscal Note prepared by the State Auditor is fair and sufficient, and Count II of the Petition is denied;


Count IV of the Petition is not ripe for adjudication and is therefore dismissed;
