Volunteer Responsibilities	Wash, dry, fold and put away clean laundry
	Sweep, mop, dust in the hospital, and perform deep cleaning
	Help with general tidying
Level of Difficulty	Physical difficulty is level 3; requires standing, lifting and bending and

(physical, mental, emotional)	Mental difficulty is level 2; requires following proper cleaning protocols;
