

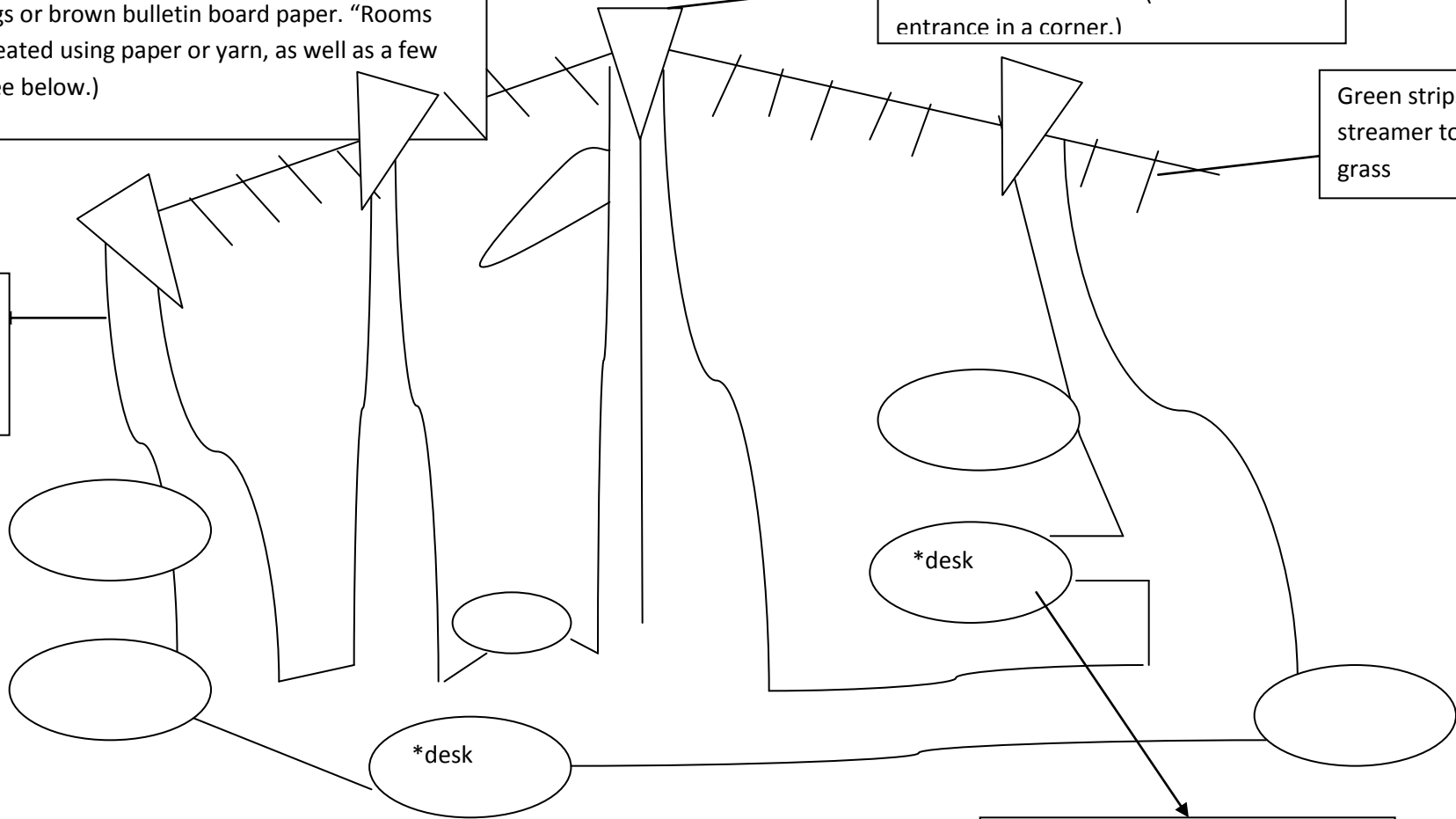
Classroom Prairie Dog Town-

Cover the back walls in brown using either brown paper bags or brown bulletin board paper. "Rooms" can be created using paper or yarn, as well as a few desks. (See below.)

Brown construction paper cut to resemble burrow holes (Place the main entrance in a corner.)

Green strips of paper or streamer to represent grass

Brown or black yarn to create tunnels.



Ideally there will be room to place a desk covered with a brown cloth or paper for the bedroom and nursery. This way student can go into the rooms during free time or silent activity. *
