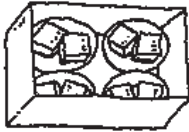

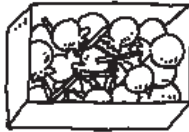

Hint: Write what you know as you go!



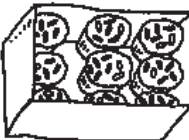
Sit Up 'N Beg

Brownies



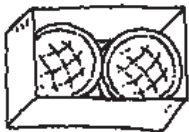
Lollipups

Items that cost 75¢ go below the brownies.

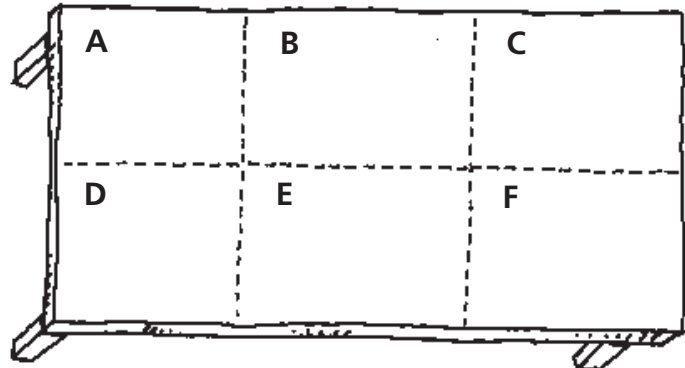
The least expensive items go in D.

If you gave Paula \$2 for a brownie, you'd get 75¢ change. That would be enough to buy your friend a cupcake!

The most expensive item goes above the least expensive one.

If you have only 25¢ to spend at the sale, you can buy a Lollipop.

The muffins go between the Lollipups and the cupcakes.
