By providing affordable spay and neuter surgeries and wellness services, the Animal Birth Control Clinic promotes responsible, lifetime pet ownership and saves lives.

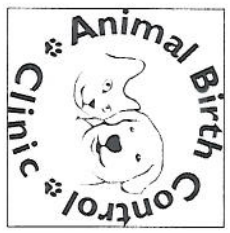


GOALS

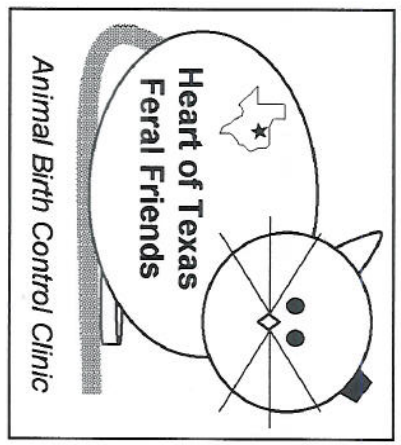

VOLUNTEER ORIENTATION & TRAINING

VOLUNTEER ORIENTATION

Volunteers attend a 30-minute orientation to learn about feral cats, our TNR efforts and our volunteer policies & procedures.

TRAINING WORKSHOP

Volunteers interested in humane trapping, colony caregiving or colony monitoring attend an additional training workshop immediately following the Volunteer Orientation. We provide additional feral cat facts, hands-on working of the humane trap, demonstrate proper trap & Release technique, familiarize you with our colony tracking form, and volunteer protocol.

YOU CAN HELP!*

VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

TRAPPING—Using humane traps, help us trap feral cats at designated colonies on specific day & time.

TRANSPORT / RELEASE—If you have an SUV or other type of enclosed back seat (no trucks or trunks, please), then help us transport cats to and from the ABC Clinic.

CAREGIVER—Responsible for providing food, fresh water, shelter and keeping the feeding stations clean of debris and excess food.

COLONY MONITOR—Track a feral cat colony on a weekly basis to check for new cats wandering into a stabilized colony so we can quickly TNR it.

PUBLIC EVENTS—Enjoy talking to people one-on-one? We need volunteers to visit with the community and hand out literature about our TNR program at ABC Clinic information booths.

FUNDRAISERS—Help out at fundraisers with set-up and breakdown, hosting and information.

FERAL CAT CLASSES—Are you good in front of a group? Help us teach Feral Cat classes to the public.

DONATIONS—Help us raise donations at your work or in your neighborhood.
