

“Pledge to Stop Puppy Mills” DRAWING RULES

1. Disclosure; Entry Period

No donation, purchase, or obligation of any kind is necessary to win. A donation or purchase will not increase your chances of winning. You have not yet won. The odds of winning depend upon the number of entries received. Entries for the “Pledge to Stop Puppy Mills” DRAWING (the “Drawing”) will be accepted beginning at 12:00 a.m. Eastern Standard Time (EST) on 11/28/2010 and ending at 11:59 p.m. EST on 12/11/2010 (“Entry Period”). Entries must be submitted by 12/11/2010 to be eligible.

2. Eligibility

You must be 18 years of age or older to enter. Void where prohibited by law. The Drawing is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Employees and independent contractors of The Humane Society of the United States (“The HSUS”) or its affiliates, and any other individual or entity involved in the development, promotion, or execution of the Drawing, and the immediate family members and/or household members of each are not eligible.

3. To Enter

To enter, fill out and sign the electronic “Pledge to Stop Puppy Mills” located at <http://action.humanesociety.org/site/Advocacy?pagename=homepage&id=4744>. An entry will be deemed ineligible if it is illegible, incomplete, if it fails to meet the required specifications, or if it is received before the Entry Period begins or after it ends.

4. How the Winner Will Be Determined

The Winner will be determined through a random drawing of all eligible entries.

5. Prizes

Three Winners will receive a signed copy of Colbie Caillat’s CD “Breakthrough.”

6. Winner Notification/Prize Claims

The Winners will be selected by 12/18/2010 and will be notified via email by 12/31/2010. In the event that a Winner is unable to accept a prize, an alternate Winner will be selected. The Winner may be required to complete and sign an Affidavit of Eligibility and Liability Release, and, where legal, a Publicity Release, all of which must be returned within 30 days of attempted prize notification or the prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner. If the prize is won by an eligible person who is not of legal age in the state of residence, the prize shall be awarded in the name of the Winner’s parent or legal guardian, who must sign and return all required documentation prior to receiving the prize. In the event of noncompliance with these Rules, or if a prize or prize notification is unclaimed or returned as undeliverable, the prize will be forfeited and may be awarded to an alternate winner.

If, for any reason, the Drawing is not capable of running as planned, or infection by computer viruses, bugs, or tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, actions of entrants, technical failures, or any other causes corrupt or infect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of the Drawing, The HSUS reserves the right at its sole discretion to disqualify any entry or entrant and/or to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the Drawing and at its sole discretion award a prize from among all eligible non-suspect entries validly received prior to the action requiring such modification.
