- 1 Chimpanzees are **our** closest living relatives.
- 2 They can live **to** be more than 50 years old.
- 3 Chimpanzees are **great** apes, as are gorillas, orangutans, bonobos—and even humans. **Monkeys** are not apes.
- 4 The easiest **way** to tell the difference between a chimpanzee and a monkey is to look for a **tail**. Most monkeys have tails; chimps do not.
- 5 **By** the time they are 3 years old, chimpanzees **weigh** about 30–40 pounds but are as strong as an adult human.
- 6 Chimpanzees communicate with each other. They use facial expressions, calls, grooming—even laughing and screaming—**to** let others **know** what they are feeling. They also comfort one another **by** kissing and **hugging**.
- 7 Chimpanzees use tools. They **strip** leaves from branches and use the twigs to “fish” **for** insects or to get honey from a beehive. They use rocks to crack open nuts and large leaves to collect water. **Young** chimpanzees learn how to use tools **from** adult chimps.
