Walk FAQ's

When is the Walk?

Sunday, September 23, 2007. Check-in starts at 11:00 am; pre-walk activities begin at noon. The walk begins at 1:00 pm.

Where is the Walk?

Sylvan Theater on the National Mall, located at the corner of 15th Street and Independence Avenue SW, near the base of the Washington Monument.

How much does it cost to register?

The on-line pre-registration fee is \$20 for individuals and \$50 for a family of 4 (no more than 2 adults ages 18 or older). On the day of the Walk, the fee is \$25 for individuals and \$60 for a family of 4.

How long is the Walk?

The one mile Walk circles the Washington Monument grounds and allows you to savor the beauty of the Nation's Mall and its historic monuments and sites.

Where do I park?

General parking is available along Ohio Dr. between the Lincoln and Jefferson Memorials. Limited handicapped parking is available at the Lincoln and FDR Memorials. If you are not bringing a canine companion, we strongly encourage you to take Metro, as parking is limited in the National Mall area. Take Metro to the Smithsonian station on the Blue/Orange lines and proceed west to 15th St.

Will there be anything to eat?

There will be doggie treats for your best friend and water for you. We encourage you to bring a picnic lunch to enjoy on the lawn!

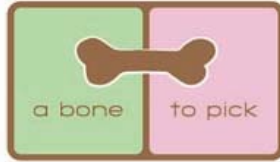
