FEEDING.

(a) The food shall be wholesome, palatable, and free from contamination and of sufficient quantity and nutritive value to maintain all animals in good health. The diet shall be prepared with consideration for the age, species, condition, size, and type of the animal. Animals shall be fed at least once a day except as dictated by hibernation, veterinary treatment, normal fasts, or other professionally accepted practices.

Currently there are 3 tigers that are being fed various ground meats, turkey necks, and other miscellaneous animal parts without any type of supplementation. The facility previously had experienced metabolic bone disease with 2 of the tigers when they were younger. If a commercially prepared diet is not fed to the tigers, the attending veterinarian must approve of the diet being fed. This may include guidance on types of meat and supplementations and recommended thawing procedures.
