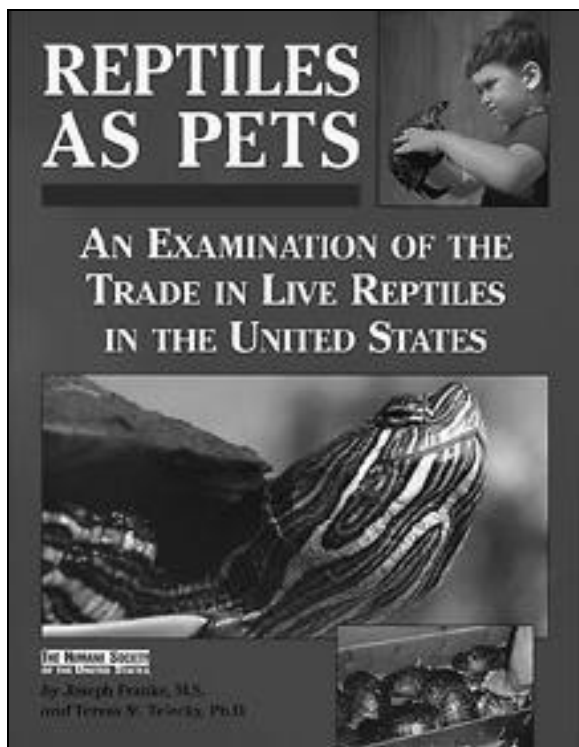
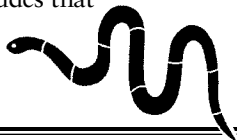


A GROWING TRADE WITH HIDDEN THREATS



Reptiles as Pets: An Examination of the Trade in Live Reptiles in the United States examines the U.S. reptile pet trade and its ramifications for the animals and the people who keep them as pets. Reptiles are becoming increasingly popular as pets in the United States. This 146-page, softcover report provides important information for consumers and others about the millions of reptiles kept as pets—their origins; the vast numbers that are imported and exported for the trade; the deplorable conditions under which traded reptiles are captured, held, and transported; the negative conservation effects of the trade; the difficulties of keeping reptiles as pets; the threats the trade poses to agriculture; and the human health hazards pet reptiles pose. While The Humane Society of the United States understands the widespread interest in reptiles, this report concludes that reptiles should not be kept as pets by the general public for the reasons fully detailed therein.
